Huck Finn Fishing Derby RULES

- 1. Huck Finn Fishing Derby is for ages 1 14 years old.
- 2. All participants will be required to check in upon arrival to the derby to receive their goody bag.
- 3. Contestants may supply their own bait. (free corn will be available near registration table)
- 4. Contest hours are from **8:15 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.** (1 hour 15 minutes of fishing)
- 5. Any fish caught before starting time **8:15 a.m.** may not be entered into the Derby.
- 6. Derby will begin and end with a blow of a whistle.
- 7. All contestants must fish from the shoreline. Boats, rafts, or any type of floatation devices will not be allowed.
- 8. Only one fishing line per participant will be authorized to be qualified for prizes in the derby.
- 9. Fish must be caught by contestants fishing pole and once measured, **fish must** be released back into Green Lake (caught and release policy).
- 10. The assistance of young contestants by parents or adults is endorsed, however parents cannot fish for their children and children must be actively involved in the catching of all fish.
- 11. Fish caught during the Derby will be measured and entered on a data sheet by the fishing derby judges. Derby fish are tallied up and looked over for a chance to win one of the four prizes.
- 12. All decisions by judges are final. Any arguments or disagreements will be immediate grounds for disqualification.
- 13. Contestants can only place within one of four categories. (One prize per contestant)
 - Longest fish
 - Most caught fish
 - Most unique catch
 - Most colorful fish
- 14. Award winners must be present at the award's ceremony to receive their prize. (9:50 a.m. near registration table).
- 15. Have a **safe** and **fun** fishing experience!
