Registration

No mail in or on-line registration will be accepted. Participants are required to complete a triplicate sports registration form at the Alcott Center and include full payment. Entering the registration lottery does not guarantee a place in the program. Random drawing will begin on September 14 for residents. Nonresidents will be drawn after all residents have been drawn and placed in a division or on a wait list. We will e-mail your receipt confirming your registration.

If you miss the above registration dates, you may put your name on a wait list at the Alcott Center during regular business hours. If space is available, you will be placed on a team after all the registration has been entered.

Fee

The basketball jersey is a mandatory uniform for basketball. Returning players may use their existing jersey, or a new jersey may be purchased.



The season begins in the middle of November and runs through the end of February. Practices are on Tuesday and Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings. On most Sundays, wrestlers may participate in a developmental tournament sponsored by another club in the metropolitan area. There, each wrestler will participate in 2 or 3 matches with the possibility of winning a trophy or medal. We typically attend 12 developmental tournaments throughout the season with an average of 30 of our wrestlers at each. At the end of the regular season, wrestlers 9 years and older may continue tournament participation at the State and National playoff levels. We have had 7 State Champions and a National Champion along with 63 state place finishers. Please note: A mandatory informational parents meeting will be on Tuesday, November 12 from 6 - 8 pm at Buffalo Grove High School in Section 4 of the field house. (CE)
