Minutes from the November 3, 2011 BG EAT meeting. Call to order at 7 pm.

Update on recent events.

- **Electronics Recycling**. Deenie Pomilia organized EAT volunteers for the September 24 electronics recycling event. Despite the rain, the event was a success, collecting vast quantities of old computers and other electronics!
- **Seed collecting.** Jeff Weiss reported that two scout groups and EAT members collected a significant native plant seed harvest. We discussed when to clean the seeds and decided to clean them after the next EAT meeting at Alcott. We will sow them at Rylko Park sometime this winter or early spring.
- Road cleanup. The Adopt-a-Highway road cleanup on October 15 was a success.

Upcoming events

- Alternative energy. Steve gave an update on power aggregation. The Village of BG banded with several other communities to investigate potential benefits and will take up the issue at the November 7 meeting. If a resolution is passed, a referendum question will be on the ballot in March and \$77 million of electricity purchasing power is in play in BG alone. Negotiating points include cost, service levels and amount of "green" energy in the mix. Steve will provide a Frequently Asked Questions sheet to BG EAT members.
- **Presentation to the BG Park District Board.** Jeff W. announced that we have a date to present 2011 projects and future plans to the board on November 14. He passed around a draft presentation, and found interest in the following new initiatives for 2012.
