



MINUTES ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION TEAM MEETING BUFFALO GROVE PARK DISTRICT APRIL 19, 2012

Jeff Weiss called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

1. Electricity Aggregation Referendum Approval, Now What? There will be details forthcoming regarding the contract with electric aggregation contractor.

2. Rain Barrel Sales – 50 sold

The distribution of the rain barrels went very smoothly and they were all picked up. In addition to Rick Missing, the PD employee who organized the sale, Mark from the EAT committee and some scouts and other volunteers helped with the distribution. The sale netted \$671.00 for EAT.

3. Adopt-a-Highway Event April 21

The event is set for 10:00 a.m. on April 21, meet at the Siemen's parking lot and it should probably not last very long. EAT has committed for another 2-year period to continue this activity.

4. Siemens Corporation Earth Day event at Rylko Park – May 18
