



MINUTES BUFFALO GROVE PARK DISTRICT ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION TEAM MARCH 7, 2013

1. Call to Order

7. Buffalo Creek Clean Water Partnership Update

Jeff Weiss reported on the partnership at the Village Board Meeting on March 4. The Partnership received a \$10,000 grant from the Lake County Watershed Management Assistance Board and is negotiating a \$104,000 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency grant to get the technological part of the plan completed. There is an Earth Day

event at Deer Grove East on April 20 and a Riverwatch training session on May 5 in Deerfield if anyone is interested.
